NATAS partners with Mastercard and major banks like Citibank, DBS, OCBC and UOB to offer freebies ranging from trolley luggage bags to "sure-win" lucky draws.

As in previous years, Travel Guard Chartis and Tenet are the two major travel insurance companies present at the event. Up to 45% discount is given to single trip policy and is popular with visitors who come to hunt for bargains. Other bargain items at the travel fair include winter clothing and photobooks.
